Business arising

TSAWA have stated that they will not accept any responsibility for any actions of Gymnastics WA or the Trampoline SMC of WA.

General business

1. Level 1 DMT rules. A bouncer may repeat **one skill only on spotter** and **one skill only on dismount** without a penalty being incurred. Any more repeats will mean no score. Ie if a bouncer does three passes with tucks on the spotter, the third pass does not count even if dismount skills are all different. Last two bounces must be two consecutive skills, one of which must be a dismount skill. Straight bounces before last two skills are not counted. No straight jumps are permitted between last two skills.
2. Pas books Pam has collected them from Gymnastics WA, all clubs need to purchase them for \$12.00, payment to Gymnastics WA. Note that the errors noted have not been fixed in the book and updates circulated on net for those revisions still need to be used
3. Badge test paperwork needs to be completed and given to pas/records officer by April 12th 2002
4. Kathy Murdoch is to be approached to go on course presenters' course as Maureen is unable to do it.
5. Re Gratton memo Jan 25th meeting Coaching course fees under education taken out by gym WA. TSAWA will not pick up costs. Which two meetings are SMC to be invited to? Minutes to be emailed to Roy and he to send out to all clubs as per tech regs. Grant application due in June, we still get it according to gratton, need to organise a meeting between SMC and Gratton to fill it out.

6. Routine cards new ones have been received from GA for badge tests and qualifying comps. These cards need to be submitted to pas/ records officer prior to commencement of comp. WA routine cards to be used by DD judges during comp and handed to pas/records officer at completion of event to be crosschecked.

7. Judging course dick will run a level one course at the beginning of June and a level two course at the beginning of July. No paperwork has been received yet but hopefully will arrive soon form Melanie. Numbers needed by April 12th. A reminder that all judges need to update each year so need to attend appropriate course.

8. Coaching course Saturday May 4th bridging course and safety module for qualified coaches. Day one general principles.
Sunday May 5th sports specific has been organised. Katelyn Lang is the proposed presenter. Cost will be \$700 for airfare and \$30 per hour lecture fees. Approx \$1100 total.
The trampoline SMC decided that they want someone who has completed and passed the course presenters course and who is currently coaching at a state level minimum to present the course here in WA. Concerns were expressed about Katelyn's suitability for presenting the course. If no one is available we seek permission to run the course ourselves.

9. State Level competition May 24th and 25th. At Armadale PCYC, venue to be advised later, depending on move.
Qualifying in level comp is allowed so no separate comp will be held.
Warm-ups 9am Sat and Sun. Cost is \$10 per event or \$25 for all three.
Dress code for comp as per tech reg 19.9.7
Dress code for presentations: club tracksuit or t-shirt, leotard and plain track pants in club colour or state tracksuit (if currently eligible)
Minimum and maximum DD as per tech regulations 19.9.6
