**General business**

2. Tech regulations have been updated to conform to Gymnastic WA specifications
3. Voting on National SMC Chairperson. The committee voted unanimously for Chuck.
4. Pas badges will be \$4.50 from next year.
5. Nationals will be from July 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> 2003. Will include meetings and coaches courses.

11. Rules for competition – we need to clarify problems. If anyone has any particular ones, please present in writing to Dick ASAP., because there are so many changes and updates, problems are arising through some people not having these changes.
12. Level three Judging Course next year, probably after Nationals.

14. Pam spoke to Russell regarding funding help for WA bouncers to compete at nationals. A levy on all bouncers was suggested but there was no seconder
