### **Changes to rules for 2004**

Re-introduction of Double-Double Bonus of 0.2 for all passes in DMT that consist of a minimum of two doubles. Bonus will be applied in all competitions held within Australia that are Non International events.

National Qualification for 9-10yr Age Group for the year 2004

National qualifying requirements for 9-10 age group to pass level 4 and also meet the following requirements in a qualifying competition:

1.      Trampoline      Score; 51.0      D.D.      3.0
2.      DMT                  Score 57.6      D.D.      1.5
3.      Tumbling          Score 50.3      D.D.      3.8

## **3. Thornlie Comp: changes to rules on Tramp.**

For 2<sup>nd</sup> and final voluntary there will be NO penalty for repeat NON-scoring skills UNLESS stated in PAS that there is to be no repeat of skills.

## **4. Level 3 Judging course**

Melanie Tonks is able to conduct the Level 3 Judging course and a judge's workshop. A request needs to be made to Russell Smart for Melanie to come to WA. It is preferable that she comes in January, probably two weeks (10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> Jan) before conference. A minimum of 6 people will be needed for the course to go ahead.

## **5. Judging at Competitions**

Some concern has been expressed that Sue Strickland hasn't understood some of the rules of Judging. She was given the opportunity to refresh her skills at the last level 1 judging course. She didn't attend that course, but will be given another opportunity to refresh her skills at another course.
