\$8000 for the State Team. It was suggested that it be split \$5000 for the team and \$3000 be held back for equipment. Although this is not enough to buy a tramp if we can put the same amount towards it the following year we can then purchase a Euro tramp. At the moment storage is a problem but this may be resolved soon hopefully.

\$3000 for Education and Events

To be held 10th and 11th January 2004, this will be the level 3 judging course which is a 2 day course. This will be 2 weeks before conference.

General Business

1 Bunbury competition has been changed to 25th & 26th October due to a hall booking conflict.

2 State Championships, to be held at Armadale PCYC on Saturday and Sunday 29th and 30th November. The level championships will be on Saturday and the Age championships on Sunday. Levels will be 1 to 6 and all three events will be held.

Age will be National Age sets, bouncers can bounce up an age to qualify for next year in tramp and DMT but can compete synchro in their own age group.

3 Calender for 2004 as per attached sheet.

4 State training for 2004 as per attached sheet. State training scheduled for October 26th, now put back a week and will be on either Nov 1st or 2nd depending on which suits Melanie Tonks better.

5 State Selection. Nomination forms to be given out at State Championships in November, a deposit of \$100 is required by March 27th, All forms are to be filled in, i.e. Medical. Etc.

6 State Age competition. Challenge Stadium next year will use National set routines. All bouncers must compete in their age group using the prescribed set for their age. This will cut down on the number of bouncers and ensure a more even competition.

7 Conference 2004 will probably only have the AGM as we will use the sessions with Melanie Tonks on January 10th to 12th as our sessions.

8 State Championships. Pam has requested help from other SMC members at the comp.

9 State Coach; with Dick resigning Melissa and Phil will take over the rest of this years state training with a view to taking over next year.
