General Business

1. Saturday and Sunday Jan 10th and 11th.

State Training will be 9am til 12.30 approx depending on numbers and Melanie. Andrew and Michelle to supervise bouncers whilst others at Judging course. Pam to ask Gratton to book a hotel in Perth for the two nights. Pam will pick her up from the airport and drop her off on Sunday night. Phil will pick her up, return her to the hotel, and take her to Thornlie.

2 Judges Booklet needs to be printed and distributed before next comp.(March 27/28)

3 It was voted not to raise the DD for level 4 for 9/10 's who are qualifying for Nationals, they will either have to bounce up in Level 5 or lose their excess DD in level 4.

4 It would be appreciated if as many people as possible could attend the forum at the conference. Nominations for SMC need to be by January 7th. There is a cocktails and buffet session which anyone can attend if they choose to.

5 The level 1 coaching course will be held on 31st January for Day one and 7/8th Feb for Day two and bridging course.

6 Richard Kontor asked if it were possible to have a list of all judges and coaches made available to the clubs.

7 We need to have a competition and recreational bouncers list available to the comp convenor and SMC. Coaches/administrators asked to send a copy of their registration form to SMC as well as GWA.

8 PAS listing, after problems at the last comp, an up to date PAS listing will be available for the comp convenor at each comp to check bouncers are competing in the correct level.

9 Gratton has spoken to other States regarding cost sharing for Nationals, so everybody pays the same amount regardless of where they come from. This would work out to approx \$200 per person.

10 Pam to write a letter to all clubs reiterating the dress code for State and Club comps, also stating the consequences of not adhering to the Dress Code.

11 At the moment 23 bouncers are likely to go to National, 15 have qualified on Tramp and DMT, and 3 or 4 on DMT only.

12 Nationals is at the Boondall Entertainment Centre, Pam to organise accommodation, trying to book Villas if possible at Virginia Palms International. We will leave on Thursday July 1st, and return home Friday 9th July. If possible we will go to Dreamworld on Friday 2nd. \$100 deposit is required by 27th March.

13 The first comp for 2004 has been changed from Thornlie to Rockingham.

14 Sponsorship, Michelle to speak to Jet Jol to see if they will sponsor us again. License plates cost \$100, resale is about \$150. Probably too expensive for most as the bouncers are mostly children. Bumper stickers would probably be a better idea, cost wise.
