Business Arising from Correspondence:

1. Queensland Invitational - March 20-21. Not enough time to organise competitors.
Victorian Championship (Easter Weekend) - April 10-11-12. Entries close March 12.
UTA Challenge – SA May 15-16. Pam to send letter to all clubs with information and nomination forms for those wishing to attend either the Victorian or South Australian Competitions.
Philippa & Dick available for South Australia and Philippa available for Victoria.
2. Russell Smart sent 6 videos – '98 Worlds – 2002-03 Nationals. Clubs please forward videos on once they have been viewed.

General Business:

1. **Hire/Purchase of Euro Trampoline/DMT** – After discussion it was proposed that we leave the purchase of a Euro Trampoline until the next shipment (possibly June). This could then be bought on a two-way share basis with Gymnastics WA. This would then be made available for use at State Events which are not necessarily held at Thornlie. Ie. Challenge Stadium in September. TSAWA could then afford to purchase a new Euro DMT for State Training/Competitions. It was suggested that TSAWA purchase TCTC's Action Euro DMT for Rockingham PCYC and TCTC to purchase Euro DMT from TSAWA. Maureen to talk to management of Rockingham PCYC.
2. **State Team Manager/s** - Pam has nominated to be State Manager for 2004. Assistant(s) will be needed. Carol nominated for the position of assistant. Dick suggests advertising through all clubs for Assistant Manager(s). Possibility of a Male Assistant as well as a female. Pam to send out Notes to all Clubs. Nomination forms given to all Club representatives at meeting. They are also in the Bulletin. Nominations to be presented to Gymnastics WA for approval.
3. **Judges for Nationals.** Nominations for Judges to attend Nationals to be presented to Gymnastics WA for approval. \$75.00 from bouncers to subsidise Coaches/ Judges going to Nationals.
4. **New State Team Guidelines** and Official Nomination forms for Competitors will be available by next State Training. The Guidelines also show an approximate cost for competitors to attend Nationals. This is a generic cost, but shows an amount of \$75 per competitor to assist with the cost of Coaches/Judges attendance. Dick suggested that we should include this amount in our costings.
5. **H.P.C. (High Performance Centre)** – To have a Trampoline HPC would cost at least \$5000 per bouncer, this is out of the reach of most people. SMC will work on having a high performance program/club from the Nationals grant monies. It was suggested that TCTC become a HPC, this being the only current non-PCYC Club suitable. Thornlie is open to this suggestion, given that they will have a EuroTramp & Euro DMT at the Club which will be available for State use.
6. **Tech Regulations – Judges Uniforms** – GWA is unable to provide T/Shirts for officials at Trampoline competitions. Judges to wear: Plain White Collared shirt/blouse, Navy Blue/Black trousers/skirt.
The new Technical Regulations should be available by next State Training Session.
7. **Volunteers Course** – Dick to co-ordinate a workshop for volunteers after the State Training on March 14th, covering Marshalling, Camera, Scoring and Spotters. Carol and Johanna will run the scoring workshop. Andrew may be available to assist with Marshalling. Workshop to start 11am. Warm up 11.30 –12. Competition 12 – 1.30pm.
Need to check within Clubs on Numbers for this course. Course is to be sanctioned as current Coaches who wish to learn more about running a Competition can use this as an updating workshop.
8. **GWA – PCYC –Memberships** – Freddie Tan has requested that all PCYC Trampoline competitor memberships to go through Pam as PCYC so that we have an accurate account of numbers and Clubs.

9. **PCYC Insurance** – At present we have been unable to ascertain whether the PCYC Insurance is sufficient for the requirement of GWA as a copy has not yet been presented. Should PCYC Insurance be insufficient, then the six PCYC Trampoline clubs will need to split the \$920 cost of the GWA Public Liability Insurance fee. PCYC has an APPRA Certificate so there is no problem there.
10. **Level 1 & Level 2 Judging Courses** will cost \$55.00 includes first year of membership for Level 1. Next Course will be Level 1 on 3rd April 2004. Nomination forms are in the current GWA Bulletin.
11. **CAPS** – An accredited Leadership course for 14 - 18year olds which includes Coaching. CAPS participants are able to get 25% discount off Accredited Coaching Courses. This course is run through the DSR and full diaries of activities and courses completed are kept.
12. Pam to check that SMC Minutes are sent to all Trampoline Clubs.
