General Business

1. GWA State Championships – 5th September

Cost is \$12 for one event or \$28 for all three. T-shirt is optional. Bouncers must be level 3 minimum, as it is an age comp there will be max or min DD but coaches must be aware of “Duty of Care” regarding bouncers’ routines. DD sheets MUST state bouncers’ current level and age. Depending on numbers, there may be finals but this will be decided when entries are in. Entries close August 9th.

Richard has agreed to hire out TCTC equipment but wants GWA to agree to cover cost of any damage incurred. Cost will be \$150 for the day. Pam to send a letter to GWA Board regarding this matter.

Marie said food and drinks would be better organised this year as it is an issue with us being there all day.

2 Level 2 Judging course – 15th August

Five people are eligible from Trampoline to take the course. Dick has prepared letters to be sent out to them. Debbs would also like to do the course, she is currently a MAG L2, WAG L2 and AEROBICS L1 coach.

3 Nationals – Reports

Melissa, Phil and Dick as tabled.

Pam – Team Manager- was disappointed by attitude of the older bouncers when outside the venue. They were argumentative and very negative. This attitude is also apparent at club comps but she did expect them to behave better when we were away.

Melissa also said that she was disappointed with their general attitude.

Pam – SMC Chair- SPTA meeting report as tabled. There is a possibility that an International coach may be coming to State Conferences. She spoke to Russell regarding him coming to our conference but he is not available but he will speak to Darren Gillis to see if he is available.

4 Where to from here? UTA – National Club Levels – National Age

UTA is in Tasmania in April 05, National Club Levels will probably be at the end of Nov 05 possibly NSW. As our bouncers are not competitive at a National level it would be better to consider taking them to a smaller interstate event where they are not so intimidated but the size of the event. We are all agreed that they need more exposure to interstate events, but cost is the major issue.

5 New PAS

Our bouncers cannot qualify at either States. We can get a general idea of the new PAS by using the new DD requirements from these comps and Bunbury. The new PAS should be out late Dec or early Jan, but depends on new FIG regulations.

6 Judges Course Presenters Course

Phil and Dick are both available to attend the course. Dick would like more info on where it is a general course presenter's course or just a judging one. Pam to find out what funding is available.

7 Overseas Coach for State(s) Conferences

There was discussion at Nationals regarding either a Canadian or Chinese coach being brought across for State conferences. Cost would be approx \$1000. WA needs a coach who can teach level 5 to 8 skills. Russell isn't available for our conference as mentioned earlier.

8 Internal Badge Test – Arena Gymsports Armadale

Permission is requested from Arena to hold two Level 3/4 internal badge-testing competitions on Tuesday 3rd August and Tuesday 17th August. Judges to be Pam Walker, Melissa Berrington and Andrea Ledbury. Please advise Pam ASAP if you have anyone wishing to attend.

9 Tumbling

Spirit Gym club will be holding a Invitational tumbling comp on Sunday Nov 21st at Challenge Stadium. The draft passes have been put together by Debbs. It is hoped it will be a way of interesting new athletes. It is hoped Judges from Gymnastics and Trampolining will be involved and Debbs would like input from the tramp clubs regarding the draft.

10 Rockingham Comp

They will be holding a Level 1 – 4 trampoline and synchro comp on Sunday September 12th at Rockingham PCYC. This is for bouncers who were not eligible to enter GWA States the week before.

11 Tony Burton

Is an English coach who is moving here early next year. He is bringing 6 Euro tramps and a couple of Euro DMTs with him. He is intending to set up a tramp club in Joondalup. He is also a course presenter so could possibly present our courses for us.

12 Cirque

Is to held on 16th October, Skada is choreographing the event. Melissa and Phil nominated to coordinate the trampoline bouncers. Rehearsals have been organised.
