General business:

1) DMT- level 0:

There will be no level 0 DMT program in 2005. All competitors will have to complete level 1 DMT requirements as set out in level 1 PAS.

2) Champion Male/Female scores:

For an athlete to be awarded champion male/female in 2005, they must compete in at least 4 competitions where the top 3 scores on DMT and Trampoline will be used in calculation for the award.

If an athlete is withdrawn from an event for any reason all scores for that athlete in the respective event will be disregarded. An athlete must make a valid attempt at all passes in any event to be eligible for an award for that event.

3) Competition venues- 3 competitions in 2005 to be allocated a venue:

State Age championships- Thornlie

Scarborough Competition- Armadale

Club Trophy Competition- Rockingham

4) New Forms: Club packs distributed to all clubs

a) Membership forms distributed

b) PAS booklets- essential to send in all sheets including master PAS form for badges to be accepted.

c) Competition Entry forms- entry forms have been altered to include first aid officer. Each club must have a nominated first aid officer present at competition venue.

d) Sign-in sheets-Judges and coaches to sign in for competitions on sign in sheets provided. Only accredited coaches may be on the competition floor and an accredited coach must always be present whilst athletes are competing.

Warm-ups- competitions should be organized where possible so that only those competing in a session may warm-up prior to that session. General equipment warm-ups will now not be used.

5) Technical regulations distributed to all clubs. Module 7 now contains all trampoline sports technical regulations.

6) Judges booklet- Melissa to work on 2005 judges booklet to align with 2005 rule changes.

7) Trophy Competition- all clubs have been distributed and should look over Eric's proposal for the 2005 trophy competition. Clubs to return with queries at the next meeting.

8) Tumbling- to be discussed at next meeting.

9) Euro Tramp- Thornlie has ordered one Euro trampoline. Another has been ordered through GWA- venue yet to be determined.

10) Trampoline Coaches conference- information has been distributed regarding conference.
