2. Euro tramp- State Euro trampoline will arrive 7th February. This will initially be transported to Rockingham until further arrangements are made. Pam will speak to Gratton about costs for clubs to hire the state euro trampoline. Sharing of the state euro trampoline to be discussed at next SMC meeting once Pam has received cost information.

-An action trampoline must be made available at every competition so clubs without access to the euro are not disadvantaged.

-The State Euro trampoline must be made available for state competitions.

General Business:

1. Copies of PAS books have been distributed to all clubs and an original copy has been ordered for each club at a cost of \$20 each.
2. Forms for the coaches conference on 12th February have been distributed and must be received by Gymnastics WA with payment before commencement of course.
3. Tasmania Competition- State leotard to be worn for UTA competition. Club leotards to be worn for Tasmanian State Championships.

Phil to organize State leotards for both Miller Best and Eric Lyon through Storm. State tracksuits and t-shirts to be also organized for these two competitors.

State trainings for Tasmania competitors as well as those wishing to travel to National Age or Nationals Clubs will be on the following dates. All competitors must hold a level 4 or above trampoline badge to attend state training.

Qualifying competition scheduled for 27th February now not necessary as all competitors have qualified for Tasmania, therefore this will not take place.

4. Officials funding- \$2000 allocated for officials support in 2005. Funding will be provided for the national age coach and other funding for officials as seen as necessary by the SMC.
5. Athlete transfers from PCYC clubs- all clubs previously registered as a PCYC club in 2004 must fill out club transfer forms for all athletes to re-register as a different club in 2005.
6. Eurotramp- as discussed in business arising from correspondence.

7. Trophy Competition- Set as a trampoline only 1 day competition. The competition structure is set out in Club Cup competition handout made by Eric. This is now the final copy and has been distributed to all clubs.

Other Business:

1. Level 2 judges course has changed to 16th July due to a clash with National club Levels Championships.

2. A member of each club must provide Pam with their club details so all clubs have a list of contacts. This must include: club name, club contact, email address, fax, phone number and street address.
